Youth Theatre Information

As our Youth Theatre classes (for 13 – 17 year olds), don't present in the middle of the year, we thought we would let you know what they are up to this term! Our Youth classes have a fantastic atmosphere of fun and team spirit. The creative results of our students' work provide some excellent in-class performances. This term, units of work covered include:

- ❖ Warm-ups including characterisation activities and group scenes.
- ❖ Speech training – voice projection, line attack (to ensure each word is clear), eye contact, breath control & some fun tongue twisters.
- ❖ Mini-scripts – in pairs, or threes, students will discuss, interpret and perform four very different scripts, allowing students opportunities to explore various delivery techniques.
- ❖ Sound tracks – Scenes to be developed in small groups and performed twice – firstly in the style of a silent movie, and then with dialogue added.
- ❖ Whole class improvisations. Each improvisation this term involves many different characters, settings, storyline suggestions and plot twists! The process requires decision-making and cooperation within the group.
- ❖ Theatre games – Requiring fast, creative planning, encouraging students to use their imaginations and create instant characterisation and conversation.

These activities require strong teacher input and guidance. Relevant feedback is given after each activity. We are very proud of the results that our teachers and students achieve each week and are sure that you can recognise the skills that are being developed through our programme.

Reminders

Drop-Off & Collection of Students

- Our teachers are not able to supervise children outside of the classroom. **Before class, please remain with your children** in the foyer or entrance until the teacher is ready to bring them into the room.
- If someone other than a child's parent or guardian is collecting them at the end of class, or your child has permission to ride or walk home alone, the class **teacher must be informed**, in writing. (See your teacher for info on our 'Signing in book'.)
- We ask **children to remain in the hall** with their teacher, if their parents have not yet arrived to collect them. Please remind your children of this rule when you bring them to class each week.
